Seedling List

This list is a guide to species usually grown by Narromine Transplants for farm forestry and farm amenity. Most of our trees are ordered in advance and **we will only ever have a very few trees on hand for immediate purchase**. Please contact our office to find out what trees we have for immediate purchase.

Orders for farm and revegetation seedlings should be placed **as early as possible**. For Spring plantings, orders should be placed in April/May, and for Autumn plantings, orders should be placed in August/September. Some species will take as long as 5 to 6 months to grow, so it is important to place orders well in advance. Seedling availability will also be affected by the availability of seed for each species. For larger plantings we can help organise seed collection.

Our seedlings are grown in Hiko trays (40 seedlings per tray). Prices for Hikos start from \$40 per tray (of 40 seedlings) (inc GST). Please contact us for forestry tube prices. When placing an order, a 30% deposit is required with the balance payable prior to or at the time of dispatch. Minimum order of 120 trees per species.

KEY TO TREE LIST

Habit	Indicates the general tree type. DS = Dwarf Shrub, SST = Tree,
H (m)	The average height in meters that a seedling could be expected to reach at maturity. This number could vary +/- 5m
Drought	H = High resistance to drought, M = Moderate resistance to drought, L = Low resistance to drought
Soil Type	H = Heavy, M = Medium, L = Light. Indicates general soil types that each species will tolerate, however consideration must be given to drainage.
Frost	H = Suitable for areas with frequent heavy frosts, M = Suitable for areas with occasional moderate to heavy frosts, L = suitable for areas with very few light frosts.
Salt	Suitable for saline soil areas or coastal plantings.
Wind	Suitable for planting as a windbreak.
Timber	Suitable for agro-forestry plantings or for general use timber production such as firewood or fence posts.
CW	Indicates a species that is native to the Central West area.
